- <u>Educational Research</u>: Must include presentation of complete or partial results that demonstrate the effectiveness (or lack of effectiveness) of an educational intervention.
- <u>Learner Assessment:</u> New or novel OSCEs, clinical evaluation tools, or simulation assessments.
- <u>Innovations:</u> new or novel ideas not commonly utilized in medical education. These may include technology such as apps, new programs or innovative task trainers.

Abstracts should include the following information:

- Title
- Authors with affiliations
- Idea
- Submission Category
- Rationale or Need
- Methods or Description
- Results, if Available
- Evaluation Plan
- Potential Impact or Lesson Learned
