

# Introduction to Research on Underrepresented Minorities in Medicine

**EDMD 9430**

<b>Course Description</b>	This course will introduce students to research on diversity in the medical profession's workforce, specifically focusing on careers in academic medicine serving underrepresented groups. Students in this course will explore quantitative, qualitative, and mixed methods of research design, ultimately participating in a research project focusing on underrepresented minorities in medicine (URMMs).
<b>Course Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify a research problem</li><li>• Construct a viable research question(s)</li><li>• Describe and discuss the process of collecting, analyzing, and reporting data to address underrepresentation in academic medicine</li><li>• Develop a study/manuscript that addresses underrepresentation in academic medicine</li></ul>
<b>Course Activities</b>	Students will engage in discussions on research around underrepresentation in medicine. Students will design research studies and conduct literatures. Students will also learn the process of journal article analysis. This course will result in the culmination of student developed manuscript for publication.
