Course Description	In this course, students will be exposed to a wide variety of outpatient and inpatient gynecologic patients. A focus will be placed on the screening and treatment of patients, with exposure to gynecologic procedures with active participation where appropriate.		
Course Objectives	 Provide appropriate screening, diagnostic, and therapeutic options for the management of common problems in women of reproductive and post-reproductive age. Describe and discuss the goals for primary care for women. Recommend age-appropriate preventative care measures for women. 		
Course Activities	The student will see patients with faculty members in morning and afternoon clinics. We anticipate a maximum of six clinics per week. These clinics are available in Gynecology at ECU Women's Physicians and the Brody Building Module C. Participation in weekly Grand Rounds and academic conferences is encouraged. In addition to the clinical activities, students will be required to write a brief
