Course Description	The Acting Internship (AI) is a comprehensive clinical experience designed to provide the student with increased responsibilities for the assessment and management of patients. Students are integrated into the health care team and will have primary responsibility for the patient's care under close supervision. The Acting Intern will experience the roles and responsibilities of an intern on the team. This AI will increase the student's knowledge of ambulatory pediatric problems, help students gain an awareness of the role of the primary care pediatrician as coordinator of care and advocate for patients, and learn the scope of community services available for patients.
