<b>Course Description</b>	This course will increase the student's knowledge of neurological problems in children and help students gain an awareness of the role of the pediatric neurologist in relationship to the primary care specialist.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify and develop management plans for common neurologic problems</li><li>• Complete a pediatric neurological examination</li><li>• Describe and discuss CT, EEG</li><li>• Recognize and classify epilepsy</li></ul>
<b>Course Activities</b>	Students in the course will encounter a variety of patient conditions, including epilepsy, tic disorders, headaches/migraines, school problems, and neurologic emergencies. Students will receive written feedback at the completion of the rotation.
