

<b>Course Description</b>	This course will provide students an intensive experience in child and adolescent psychiatry with a special focus on diagnosis and treatment modalities.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Perform a diagnostic assessment</li> <li>• Formulate a practical treatment plan</li> <li>• Practice professional communication and collaboration by working with multidisciplinary teams using a developmental approach to child and adolescent psychiatry patients</li> <li>• Describe and discuss multiple therapeutic modalities</li> </ul>
<b>Course Activities</b>	Students in this course will participate in outpatient clinics at a variety of sites, as well as select residential treatment programs for children and adolescents. Students will attend both didactic courses and Grand Rounds.
<b>Course Schedule Requirements</b>	No on-call requirement. Student is present during usual clinical hours (8:00am – 5:00pm, Monday – Friday, excluding holidays as determined by the ECU calendar).
