Course Description	The Acting Internship (AI) in Inpatient Psychiatry is a comprehensive clinical experience designed to provide the student with increased responsibilities for the assessment and management of patients. Students are integrated into the health care team and will have primary responsibility for the patient's care under close supervision. The Acting Intern will experience the roles and responsibilities of an intern on the team. This AI will provide the student with a more advanced inpatient rotation for the clinical management and treatment of severely ill hospitalized psychiatric patients.

Research projects are a possibility and should be discussed with the director.
