

Course Description	In this course, students will work directly under the supervision of PM&R faculty and resident physicians to care for patients in a rehabilitation outpatient setting.
Course Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe and discuss the use of a function-based approach to patient care, and how medical illnesses and injuries affect an individual's ability to function in society • Describe the role of different providers in the care of patients • Practice professional communication and collaboration with other providers to provide patient care • Identify different allied health services and develop treatment plans that include appropriate services and therapeutic exercise programs
Course Activities	Students in this course will participate in patient evaluation and management in a variety of outpatient clinics. Students will work interprofessionally with other allied health professionals, including physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech-language therapy. Students will be expected to review potential current PM&R research activities.
