



AIM Statement

To improve patient safety during transitions of care by increasing reconciliation of both *local* and *outside* patient problems, medications, and allergies to 80% of all hospitalizations for 90 consecutive days in all Vidant Health Hospitals by January 2022.

Baseline Data (October 2020)

Allergies	99.9%	87.7%




1. Training

- Showed an individualized baseline
- Outlined Workflow Options
- Actual patient demonstrations
- Encouraged Adding the Column
- 2. Deliver division monthly performance
- 3. Follow-up with additional support
 - Individualized Performance Reports
 - December Floor Scramble


















Challenges

- Physician & APP engagement with problem reconciliation
- Brand New Metric → Epic fine-tuning workflow
 - Many duplicates
- Obtaining the right data
 - 90 days → 30 days
 - Hospital units → specific providers





Lessons Learned

- Training needed to include demonstrations on actual patients
- Monitoring and delivering performance helped create and sustain increases
- Only modifying the EHR did not improve reconciliation
- Community hospitals increased faster than VMC





Next Steps → Sustainability

- Continue to monitor & deliver performance
- Streamline performance analysis and delivery
- Follow up with areas with performance decreases
- Continue to work with Epic/project team to maximize automatic reconciliation
