Course Description	<p>This online experience will introduce students to the field of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation over 1 week. Learners will spend half-days reviewing the different PM&amp;R subspecialties in both inpatient and outpatient settings, incorporating introduction to key procedures and case discussions.
