We will assess participation and knowledge with weekly assignments and quizzes.

Course Activities	The course will be structured with half day activities daily through the week, supplemented with reading materials and recorded lectures. Students are also expected to attend resident lectures, including grand rounds, tumor boards, case conferences and chairman's conferences. Students are also required to participate in online group discussions with residents and faculty as well as online discussion boards. There will be a mandatory weekly simulation session on various pediatric topics for the students to attend.
