<b>Character-Limited Course Title</b>	Primary Care and Policy
<b>Course Location</b>	Family Medicine Center 101 Heart Dr Greenville, NC 27834
<b>Course Description</b>	The purpose of this course is to expose students to medical problems commonly seen in ambulatory practice and to offer opportunities to learn about healthcare policy and how to be a physician leader.
<b>Educational Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize and manage illnesses commonly encountered by family physicians in office settings.</li> <li>Interpret basic laboratory, imaging and other diagnostic studies and assess their importance and priority for the patient.</li> <li>Communicate and work effectively with members of the healthcare team including physicians, advanced level practitioners, nurses, medical office assistants, therapists, health coaches, social workers, and patient access staff.</li> <li>Communicate effectively with patients and their families, and identify the physical, psychological, and social effects that illness have on patients and their families.</li> <li>Demonstrate effective medical documentation and EMR use.</li> <li>Describe the basics of medical costs and reimbursement issues.</li> <li>Perform basic procedures under direct supervision, as available.</li> <li>Recognize the importance of physician leadership regarding healthcare policy.</li> <li>Participate in state and local leadership meetings including the NCAFP</li> <li>Describe effective ways to be a physician leader</li> </ul>

<b>Course Activities</b>	Ambulatory patient care at Family Medicine Center: 8 -10 hours daily and other assignments at the discretion of preceptor. Evening meetings (virtual or in person) possible in lieu of afternoons without clinic. Students should be aware of evening obligations
<b>Required Readings</b>	Use of available academic resources at point-of-care (e.g., DynaMedex).
<b>Course Assessment</b>	Direct observation of student's patient encounters, case presentations, and written notes in EMR by the preceptor. Student will receive ongoing, mid-course, and end-of-course formative feedback during discussion with the preceptor.  The Brody School of Medicine Clinical Evaluation Tool utilizes behaviorally based anchors to assess student performance.
<b>Schedule Requirements</b>	No on-call requirement. Student is present during usual clinical hours (8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday), excluding holidays as determined by ECU calendar.  Due to scheduled administrative time, students will be expected to participate in scheduled leadership activities, which can occur in person or virtually after 5pm. This time will be balanced with clinic time to ensure the student has the best clinic and leadership experience.
