INTERVIEW REFLECTION

Mrs. Rose Parker is a Bethel community member who is originally from Oak City and currently lives in Scotland Neck. She grew up on a chicken farm with 3 siblings and attended ECU for her teaching degree. She provided her perspective on spiritual health in the Bethel community:

- People are so busy that they aren't thinking of eternity.
- People say they are more spiritual than they are.
- Spirituality is not a priority in the same way as her childhood.
- There is a lack of community between churches in Bethel. Churches are mostly segregated with separate Black, White, and Hispanic churches.

Food


- There are no local grocery stores.
- There are three locally owned restaurants, Da-Nite Lunch, La Casetta Italian Restaurant, and MB Grill.


Healthcare
