Medical Student Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure

1. **STOP** using the contaminated needle/suture/sharp.
2. **CLEAN/RINSE** the exposure site.
3. **REPORT** it to your supervisor immediately.
4. **ID** source patient.
5. **CALL** for help. (See below for details.)
6. **SEEK** evaluation.
7. **SCHEDULE** follow-up surveillance.
